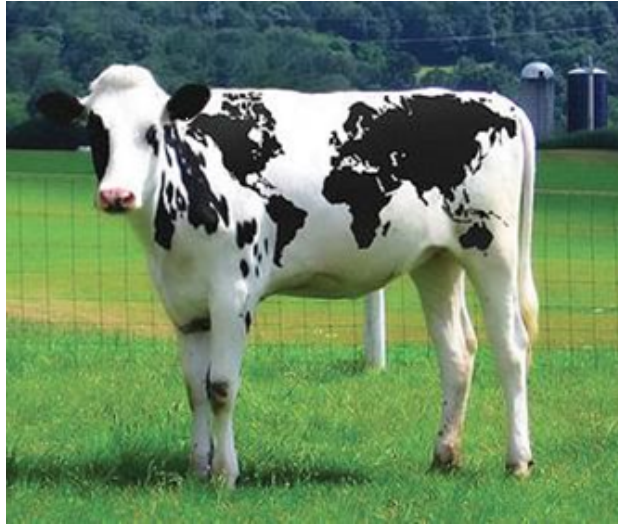


Don't Have a Cow, Man!



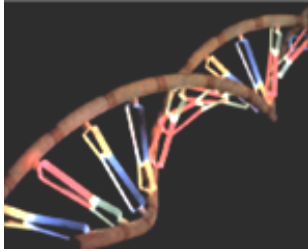
Are the spots on this cow natural ... or were they designed by a Photoshop artist?

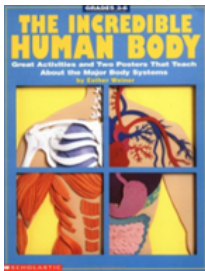
nature all around us, evolution says that everything was the result of mindless, natural processes— the philosophy of naturalism.

For all have sinned [disobeyed God], and come short of the glory [perfection] of God; (Romans 3:23)

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

But God commends his love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

“Okay, so I’m a sinner. How can Jesus help me?”

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, indeed being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the Spirit. (1 Peter 3:18)

“But isn’t Jesus just one of many ways I can be saved?”

And there is salvation in no other One; for there is no other name under Heaven given among men by which we must be saved. (Acts 4:12) Jesus said to him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father, but by me. (John 14:6)

“Can’t I get to heaven by obeying God’s commandments as best as I can?”

Therefore by the deeds of the Law none of all flesh will be justified in His sight: for through the Law is the knowledge of sin. (Romans 3:20)

“So what does the Bible say about how to be saved?”

The Bible says that the power to save us from this evil age lies with God. Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us. (Titus 3:5)

For by grace you are saved through faith [trust]. (Ephesians 2:8)

“You mean just like I trust the chairs I sit on?”

Yes! You trust (believe) without a full understanding that they, like Jesus Christ, will hold you up!

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you shall be saved (Acts 16:31). The word is near you, even in your mouth and in your heart; that is the word of faith... Because if you confess the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth one confesses unto salvation. (Romans 10:8-10)
