


Would you be surprised to find out that this is not a venomous snake but the underside of a harmless caterpillar?



Have you ever heard of a harmless caterpillar that can make itself look and act just like a deadly snake?

Not only does the caterpillar look like a snake, it even acts like one, harmlessly striking at predators as if it could kill. Even its shiny eye spots are menacing!


