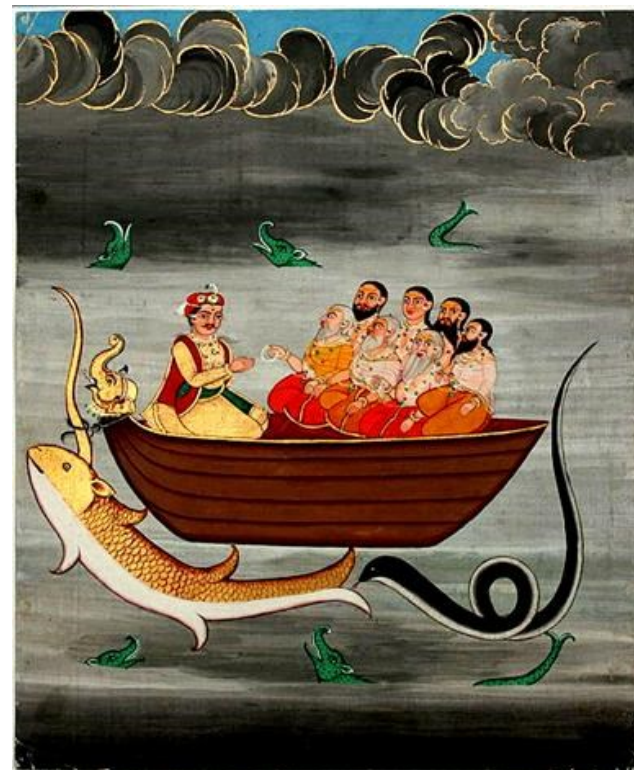

A Flood of Flood Legends

There are hundreds of stories from different cultures around the world about a devastating worldwide flood. The chart above shows the similarities that a sample of these myths from all over the world have with the Genesis account of Noah's Flood—evidence that it was the same historical event.

We can test contrary claims. If the Bible's account of a worldwide flood is true, the memory of this event would have been passed down to the descendants of Noah and spread across the whole face of the earth.

And this is what we find with all the Flood legends. Though certain details differ from the Bible, many others are the same. For example:

- The ancient Greek flood hero was told to build and stock an ark because the god Zeus wished to destroy humanity.
- The Aztec story of a universal flood says it took place 1,716 years after the creation of the world—almost the same as the Bible's date!
- The Babylonian flood story shares seven major details with the Bible's account. Similar stories are found around the world, including Australia, India, Scandinavia and China.
- The universality of the flood stories and their similarity to the Bible cannot be explained unless they are based on an event that actually took place.

What's remarkable, is that not only do many of the details of these stories agree with the Bible, they also tend to agree with each other! This is precisely what happens with "corroborating testimony".

And they also agree with the fossil evidence. Literally trillions of dead things somehow were trapped in sudden death in rocks all over the world. These rocks were once waterlogged, sedimentary rocks, which by definition were at one time soils laid down by water.

The Bible refers to the great watery cataclysm of The Great Flood in many places. God judged the world once before, and another global judgement is coming. 2 Peter 3:6,7 "...the world that then was, being flooded by water, perished. But the present heavens and the earth..., are being kept for fire until the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men."

But the good news, the Gospel, is that God has made a way to reconcile the

"world" to Himself! Read on to find out how you can have a personal relationship with the God who has promised to protect those who put their trust in His Son.

Here's what you need to know, based on words from the Creator's own book, the Bible:

God's original design for mankind was disrupted by sin.

For all have sinned [disobeyed God], and come short of the glory [beautiful perfection] of God; (Romans 3:23)

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

But God commends his love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

"Okay, so I'm a sinner. How can Jesus help me?"

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, indeed being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the Spirit. (1 Peter 3:18)

"But isn't Jesus just one of many ways I can be saved?"

And there is salvation in no other One; for there is no other name under Heaven given among men by which we must be saved. (Acts 4:12) Jesus said to him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father, but by me. (John 14:6)

Can't I get to heaven by obeying God's commandments as best as I can?"

Therefore by the deeds of the Law none of all flesh will be justified in His sight: for through the Law is the knowledge of sin. (Romans 3:20)
